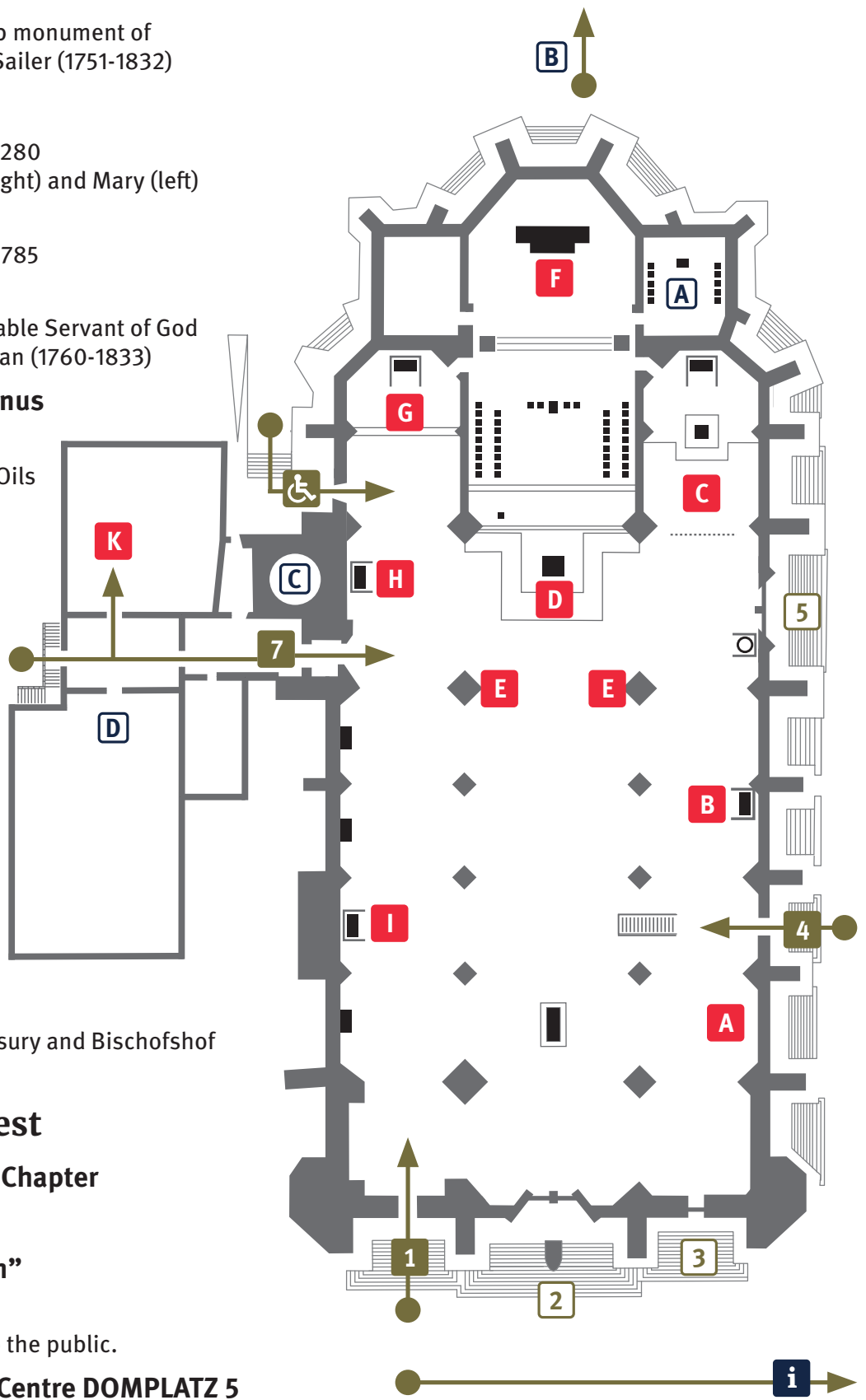
- A** **Statue of St Peter** ca. 1420

Here you can light a candle.
- C** **Sailer Chapel**
Reserved for private prayer
Altar of the Nativity and tomb monument of
Bishop Johann Michael von Sailer (1751-1832)
- D** **Main altar and ambo**
- E** **Annunciation Group** ca. 1280
So called “Smiling Angel” (right) and Mary (left)
- F** **Baroque Silver Altar**
Donated between 1695 and 1785
- G** **Altar of St Ursula**
In front: Tomb of the honourable Servant of God
Bishop Georg Michael Wittman (1760-1833)
- H** **Altar of St Albertus Magnus**
